

Musical Theatre Intensive Summer Camp

PLEASE NOTE THAT SPACE IS EXTREMELY LIMITED. YOU MUST PRE-REGISTER YOUR CHILD ONLINE TO RESERVE THEIR SPOT.

As Haven continues to grow, our goal is to make sure that each of our students are still receiving focused and quality arts education. This particular camp program has been designed to address our Haven students who feel as if they “fall through the cracks” - students who need that extra boost of instruction in order to achieve their goals. For this reason, we are capping our camper capacity at 30 students only. This small group environment allows for one on one instruction and guaranteed solo performing experiences.

A select group of campers will spend their two weeks of camp learning and rehearsing a variety of numbers, which they will present as a Musical Review in a black box theatre performance. With a focus on technique and solo performance opportunities, campers will gain tools for continued growth and future success in our program.

Pre-Requisites: Potential campers must have been a cast member in at least one Haven show.
